

RESOLUTION 21-04

WHEREAS the Elk County Board of Commissioners has the authority pursuant to K.S.A. 2-1314(d)(1), to declare certain plants as noxious weeds within the boundaries of their respective county; and

WHEREAS the Elk County Noxious Weed Department has discovered Common Teasel and Cut-leaf Teasel within the boundaries of Elk County; and


WHEREAS it is important for the Elk County Commission to protect its agricultural industry from invasive plant species; and

WHEREAS the above referenced teasel species have been shown to be evasive species; and

WHEREAS the Secretary of Agriculture has been consulted and concurs with the designation of the above plants to be noxious weeds in Elk County, Kansas.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Common Teasel and Cut-leaf Teasel are hereby declared noxious weeds within the boundaries of Elk County, Kansas. That the noxious weed director is authorized to adopt official methods of control and eradication of said declared noxious weeds and such control and eradication methods shall be approved by the Secretary of Agriculture. Further, that chemical materials shall be made available pursuant to K.S.A. 2-1322 and amendments thereto for the control and eradication of Common Teasel and Cut-leaf Teasel.


